5.	What river is the largest river system in North America that flows about 2,320 miles in length? It originates in Minnesota and flows south to the Gulf of Mexico.
6.	What large lake system is located on the border of the U.S. & Canada?

7.	What large canyon is located in Northern Arizona?
8.	What mountain peak, located in Alaska, is approximately 20,320 feet?
9.	What are the subtropical wetlands located in the southeastern portion of the U.S in the state of Florida.
10.	What is the large lake located in the northern part of the United States in the state of Utah? It is the largest salt lake in the western hemisphere.
11.	What are the broad grasslands which lie west of the Mississippi River and east of the Rocky Mountains that cover parts of the Colorado, Kansas, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas and Wyoming?
12.	What is the mountain range located in the states of California and Nevada, between the California Central Valley and the Basin and Range Province?

13.	What is the hottest and driest desert in the United States? It is the second-lowest point in the Western Hemisphere and is located east of the Sierra Nevada in the Great Basin in southern California and Nevada.
